#### **Benchmark**


A standard of excellence or achievement against which similar things must or should be measured or judged.

Vault's industry specific compensation and benefits surveys provide vital information that takes the guesswork out of the hiring and promotional process, including:

# 2025 Compensation & Benefits Study

- Growing program in 2025
  - Encourage membership
  - Invite industry to participate
- Goal is to provide more granular data by:
  - company region,
  - employee size,
  - and revenue

## Study Methodology

- Online survey delivered to members
- Just under 10% response rate
- For each position captured:
  - # of salaried / hourly FTEs
  - Average base pay
  - Minimum & maximum base pay
  - Most recent bonus


